OUR EMPLOYMENT PROGRAMMES

SO HOW CAN YOUR COMPANY HELP MAKE A DIFFERENCE AND ENGAGE STAFF AT THE SAME TIME?

Below are just some of the options available for engaging with our employment programmes. We always welcome the opportunity to talk to companies about how they can get involved.

- Work Experience Placements Work placements are a crucial offering from employers, giving participants a chance to gain employment experience for their CV and get a recent reference. Placements can last from 4 weeks to 6 months. We provide full support to companies before and during work placements
- **Business-led Workshops** on many aspects of job seeking and employment. Key areas include interview workshops; using social media to find employment; telephone skills for interviews and in work; online applications; working in retail, customer care and 'going the extra mile'
- Mock Interviews Extremely beneficial for our clients, mock interviews are conducted by business volunteers who also provide comprehensive feedback to participants
- Mentoring in different industry areas to help our clients understand the particular business sector where they would like to work, including what roles there are in Ireland, organisations to join, qualifications needed
- IT Skills Training this training focuses on the use of Microsoft Office Word, Excel and PowerPoint. We would be delighted to speak with your company about any other training you could provide particularly regarding using social media to find employment.

HOW WE SUPPORT OUR PARTICIPANTS

We want to ensure our programme participants have the best chance to find employment so we offer a holistic service to support them. This ranges from pre-employment training covering areas such as CV writing techniques, mock interviews, telephone skills and how to apply for jobs. We also offer information sessions to increase understanding of the Irish system and culture, personalised advice on social welfare, housing, family and other issues, free access to computers for online job searching and a certificate of participation upon completion of the training.
