We offer FREE training and one-to-one support for refugees and asylum seekers who are looking for a job and want to integrate into Irish society.

We have over 10 years' experience working with migrants from diverse backgrounds and nationalities. Since 2008, EPIC has impacted the lives of over 3,500 people from 101 nationalities with 68% of our participants having found jobs, entered training or volunteering.

Who is it for?

Adults living in Ireland with good level of English who are

- Asylum seekers with work permits
- Refugees with stamp 4
- Ukrainian Refugees with a Temporary Protection Certificate
- People with Subsidiary Protection or Leave to Remain and Stamp 4
- People from a refugee background and Irish passport

What is included in the EPIC Programme?

Pre-employment Training

Six weeks running Monday to Friday (morning group 10am to 1pm; afternoon group 2 to 5pm). During EPIC you will:

- Learn how to apply for jobs, training courses, education and internships
- Work on your CV
- Identify and talk about your skills & experience
- Learn professional English vocabulary
- Explore what kind of employment you want
- Prepare for interviews

Individual support from Career Counsellors

- Career Guidance and planning
- Help with job applications
- Interview coaching
- Referrals to hiring companies

Other Benefits

- Supports from businesses including IT training, LinkedIn training, practice interviews, workshops by HR experts, networking, mentoring
- Advice on social welfare, housing, family and other issues
- Integration training sessions on topics including employment rights, social welfare, access to healthcare, social integration
- Certificate of Participation on completion of the training
